WHY IS IT CALLED 10 FINE?

10 Fine is sifted through a #10 sieve to separate fine and coarse granules.

HOW DOES REDMOND COMPARE TO HEAVY MINERAL MIXES?

Some mineral programs offer heavy doses of minerals mixed with a small amount of salt. Unfortunately heavy mineral supplements easily tip the scales too far in one direction or another. When it comes to minerals, any imbalance is unhealthy-- too little is just as bad as too much. Plus, some minerals taste bitter, so heavy mineral supplements with low salt are much less palatable to your animals.

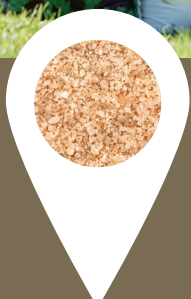
