HOW AND WHEN SHOULD I USE BEEF MINERAL?

For animals living under poor forage and feed conditions, offer free choice year round or mixed with feed rations. Testing your feed and forage will help you know whether to use Redmond 10 Fine (for animals on good quality feed and forage), Redmond Selenium 90 (for deficient feed and forage), or Redmond Beef Mineral.

CAN DAIRY COWS EAT REDMOND BEEF MINERAL MIX?
