

### WHAT IS CONDITIONER MADE OF?

Redmond Mineral Conditioner is made from weathered volcanic ash that is naturally imbibed with a full spectrum of sea minerals from our ancient sea deposit. Geologically it is also referred to as bentonite, smectite, or montmorillonite clay.

### HOW DO I USE CONDITIONER?

dairy cattle grain fed beef cattle 4-8 oz. per head per day and/or free choice



beef cattle 3-4 oz. per head per day and/or free choice



smaller cattle 2-3 oz. per head per day



sheep + goats .5-1 oz per head per day or free choice



swine 1% of total feed (20 lbs/ton)



poultry 1% of total feed (20 lbs/ton)
