FREQUENTLY ASKED OUESTIONS

HOW LONG SHOULD I USE FIRST MONTH?

You should use First Month for at least 1 month; 2 months is beneficial. This gets your calves past their most vulnerable health period and on their way to healthy growth into adulthood. For every 1lb of dry matter intake in the first 2 months of life, there are 18 more pounds of milk intake during the first lactation phase.

HOW MUCH DOES FIRST MONTH COST?

Depending on location and shipping costs, First Month usually costs around \$8-9 per calf in the first month of use

RECOMMENDED FEEDING RATES:



calves

4 grams per feeding 8 grams per day (2 doses)





2 grams per head per day divided among feedings

Milk mixing instructions

- 1. Measure 2 qts of milk
- 2. Add 1 tsp (about 4 grams) First Month
- 3. Mix thoroughly
- 4. Feed to calf
- 5. Reduce measurements by half for lambs + kids

Replacer instructions

- 1. Add 1 quart of water
- 2. Add preferred dry milk replacer and mix lightly
- 3. Mix in 1 tsp (about 4 grams) First Month
- 4. Add remaining quart of water and mix thoroughly
- 5. Feed to calf
- 6. Reduce measurements by half for lambs + kids

Syringe instructions

Calves- 30 cc per day Kids +Lambs- 7 cc per day

- Can be divided into multiple feedings
- Disinfect syringe between doses
