

Redmond products do not contain dried distiller grains with solubles (DDGS); they simply do not need it. Plus DDGS products require very careful moderation to ensure smaller animals do not eat too much.

CAN SHEEP EAT REDMOND GOAT MINERAL?

No, sheep should eat properly rationed 10 Fine, Selenium 90, or specially formulated Redmond Sheep Mineral to make sure their copper levels stay within healthy limits.
