HOW DO I KNOW IF MY ANIMALS NEED EXTRA SELENIUM?

Most North American soils are selenium deficient. Deficiencies can be found in vet blood tests, milk tests, and living liver biopsies. Poor reproductive and immune health are also strong signs of deficiency.

HOW DO I USE SELENIUM 90?

For animals on deficient feed or forage. Offer at least 30 days before birthing and through breeding season for both males and females. Easy to offer free choice or mix in with feed rations.
