Dr. Lon Whitlow of North Carolina University has studied toxins extensively and found Hydrated Sodium Calcium Aluminosilicate (HSCAS) to be effective at controlling them. The following graph is from one of his studies.



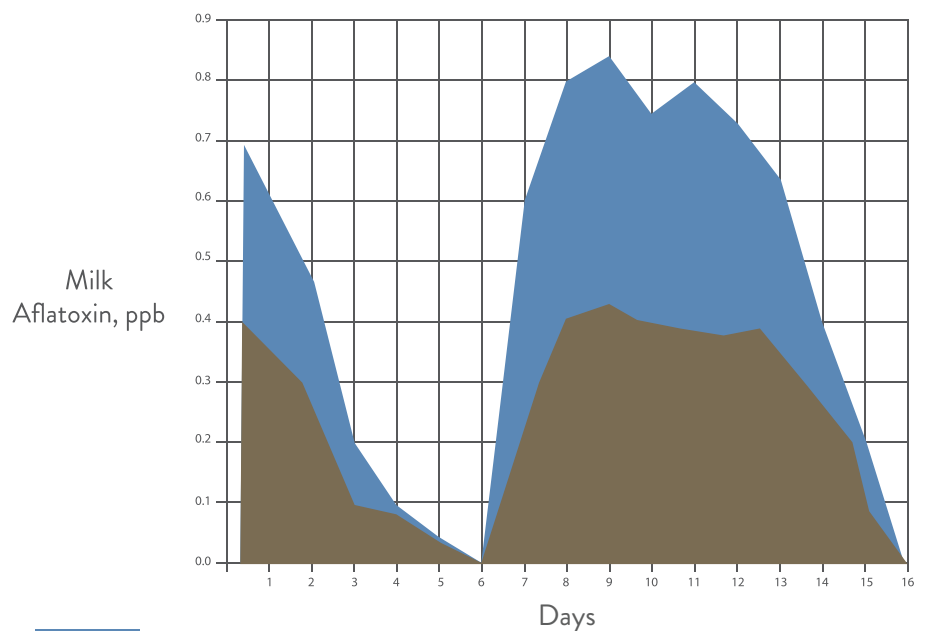
Redmond Conditioner is an HSCAS and we've conducted our own tests on the adsorption of toxins when included in the diet. The following chart shows the results.

Analysis Compound	% of Bound Toxins
Aflatoxin	99.2
T-2	85.9
Zearalenone	41.3
Doxynivalenol	12.8
Fumonisin	11.9
