WHEN SHOULD I USE BLOCKS VS. LOOSE MINERALS?



- Reduce harmful boredom behaviors (cribbing, property destruction, self-biting, etc.)
- ✓ Easily increase your number of mineral stations for large lots and pastures



- Increase intake during weather stress or seasons of heightened activity (calving, breeding, etc.)
- ✓ Reduce pecking order bullying by spreading minerals out in larger stations or add feeders

HOW TO SWITCH FROM HEAVY MINERAL MIXES TO REDMOND



Start by offering Redmond 10 Fine or 4 Medium to your animals; most animals instinctively favor Redmond's higher salt to mineral ratio.



If they don't catch on right away, they are likely over-mineralized or hooked on the grain fillers and molasses enticers in the heavy mineral/low salt mixes.



Remove the heavy mineral mix for 2-3 weeks, re-introduce both options side by side. If they are still consuming a fair amount of the heavy mix try the next step.



Get a mix without enticers and offer next to Redmond Selenium 90 (which has the fortified ratios they need at a cheaper price than the heavy minerals).
